This forum will be conducted by many international experts from all continents. Five sessions will deal with the following topics: « Lifelong learning: the stakes », « Lifelong learning: what networks? », « Learning cities and regions », « Learning companies » and « The future of lifelong learning ».

The expected speakers are: Edgar MORIN, Anthro-po-sociologist and philosopher (France), Adama OUANE (Mali), Director of the UNESCO Institute for Lifelong Learning, our partner, Pedro PONTUAL, President of the Adult Education Council of Latin America (Brazil), Keming HAO, President of the China Society of Educational Development Strategies as well as human resources managers of multinational companies.

A protocol was signed with the « China International Travel Service » agency which offers to organise your stay in Shanghai with an « A » programme from 20 to 25 July or a « B » programme from 20 July to 5 August 2010.

In times of economic crisis, what roles can lifelong learning play?

The second edition of the world forum takes on its full meaning with the theme of the Shanghai World Expo: "Better City, Better Life". The Lifelong Learning World Committee is always wondering about the relationships between the global and local levels whilst giving intermediary players the floor. The idea of lifelong learning (from a very young age to the end of life) was reiterated during the first international forum at UNESCO-Paris in October 2008. It was also dominant at Belém in December 2009 during CONFINTEA VI (6th International Conference on Adult Education). Everybody can develop their skills all through their lives, despite some difficult contexts, and flourish on a professional, a personal and a citizen's level.

This second international event is aimed at all players and decision-makers of all the countries that are directly in charge of lifelong learning. This time the forum will emphasize the role of learning territories where companies, public communities and civil society play an essential part. The World Committee strongly wishes to have all forms of learning recognized: formal, non-formal and informal education (on an individual or a collective scale) as well as experience recognition. The World Committee advocates pedagogical innovation and anticipates the needs in education and training. All the countries in the world will have those needs, sooner or later, in a context of questioning and deep global transformations. Lifelong learning contributes actively to the socioeconomic progress of nations and to their future. Nobody denies it now. The Shanghai forum will trigger a worldwide recognition movement of all forms of knowledge. It will be an opportunity to share ideas and think about the international educational revolution which is underway and about a way of living in harmony.

### **A PROGRAMME: Forum + World Expo: from Tuesday 20 July to Sunday 25 July 2010** **(6 days)**

**Tuesday 20 July:** departure from Paris CDG. Flight n° MU 554 at 12:40.

**Wednesday 21 July:** - arrival in Shanghai at 07:30 local time. Transfer to the hotel

- rest in the morning

- visit of Shanghai in the afternoon from 2 pm: Mandarin Gardens, Yu old city, Tea House, walk on the Bund.

- Evening show: Circus of Shanghai

**Thursday 22 July:** - morning and afternoon: another visit of Shanghai and its surroundings: Museum of Shanghai, Jade Buddha Temple, walk in the Xintiandi district. (Lunch with the group not included in price). Return to the hotel, transfer to the Expo site.

- 6 pm: opening ceremony of the Forum at the « Paris Ile-de-France » Pavilion.

- 9 pm: return to the hotel.

**Friday 23 July:** all-day World Forum at the France Pavilion (return trips provided)

**Saturday 24 July:** visit of the World Expo (leaving the hotel at 9.30 am, leaving the Expo at 5.30 pm, return trips provided).

**B PROGRAMME: Forum + World Expo + cultural visit of China: from Tuesday 20 July to Thursday 5 August 2010 (17 days): A programme + extended stay from Monday 26 July to Thursday 5 August 2010**

**Monday 26 July: Shanghai - Suzhou**

Go to Suzhou. Visit Luzhi water village on the way. Arrival in Suzhou. Visit of the Master of Nets Gardens and of the Silk Factory. Night stay.

**Tuesday 27/7 Suzhou - Nanking**

Visit of the Liu Gardens, boat trip on the canals (small boats). In the afternoon, departure for Nanking. Arrival in Nanking, visit of the Big Bridge of the Yangtze River. Walk in town. Night stay.

**Wednesday 28/7 Nanking - Luoyang (12 hours on the night train)**

Visit of the provincial museum, of the Mausoleum of Dr. Sun Yatsen and stroll in the Linggu park. Transfer to the station after dinner, night train to Luoyang, night stay on train.

**Thursday 29/7 Luoyang - Shaolin Temple - Luoyang**

Meet at the station. Departure for the Shaolin temple, 100 km from Luoyang. Visit of the Shaolin temple with a demonstration of martial arts (Gong Fu). Night stay in Luoyang.

**Friday 30/7 Luoyang**

Visit of the Buddhist Longmen caves, of the White Horse Temple and walk in town. Night stay.

**Saturday 31/7 Luoyang- Xi'an**

Train to Xi'an: G2001 train (8:36 - 10:29 am). Meet at the Xi'an station. Visit of the Emperor Qinshi Huangdi clay army. Visit of the Big Mosque and walk in the local Muslim quarters. Dinner of ravioli. Night stay.

**Sunday 01/8 Xi'an/Beijing**

Visit of the Big Pagoda of the Wild Goose, of the history museum, of the jade factory and walk in town with the view of the Bell and Drum Tower. Evening flight to Beijing. Meet at the Beijing airport, transfer to the hotel. Night stay in Beijing.

**Monday 02/8 Beijing**

Excursion on the Great Wall of China in Juyongguan, to the Ming tombs and the Sacred Way , dinner: the Beijing « lacquered duck » specialty. Night.

**Tuesday 03/8 Beijing**

Discovery of the Forbidden City, of the Sky Temple, and of the Liulichang street renowned for antiques. Night stay.

**Wednesday 04/8 Beijing**

Visit of the Summer Palace, the Lamas temple and the Confucius temple. Night stay.

**Thursday 05/8 Beijing - Departure**

Transfer to the airport, end of services.
